- <u>eRecord</u> is the name of the integrated electronic health record (EHR) which has been implemented at both Strong Memorial and Highland Hospitals. The new system will serve both hospitals' inpatient areas, emergency departments, and outpatient areas.
- <u>ePartner</u> provides community providers and select staff with full access to the patient chart (i.e., lab results, discharge notes, images), but you will not be able to contribute to the chart in any way.
